Safety Reminder - Recent Thefts

On Sunday night, July 13, cash was taken from a wallet in a car on Airdrie Court. In addition, cash was taken from a purse on Gallaher Court. (It is unconfirmed, but it is believed the purse was accessed inside the home while residents were sleeping.) A perpetrator was arrested within 4 hours, but at this point, it is not known whether this person was involved in just one or both incidents.

On Tuesday night, July 15, items were taken from an unlocked car on Whileaway Drive.

PLEASE remember the following:

- Remove all valuables from inside vehicles.
- Lock car doors (and preferably park inside your garage.)
- Close garage doors.
- Lock doors of your home.
- Keep an eye out. If you see unknown and/or suspicious people in the neighborhood, do not hesitate to call Miami Township Police, either 911 for emergency, or 732-2231 for non-emergency.

Unfortunately, summer brings out some criminal elements, and they will be looking for opportunities. Please be vigilant.
